What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer by websites. They enable the website to identify your computer across multiple pages during your visit or on subsequent visits. This improves your experience by allowing you to use the site more efficiently, saving you time since you don't need to re-enter details on each visit. Cookies also ensure you receive the most relevant information from us. Additionally, they help us analyse customer interaction with our sites for continuous improvements.

All cookies we use are anonymous and are never linked to your personal information.

Types of Cookies We Use

Session Cookies

 Named PHPSESSID, these are essential for functions like maintaining log-in details or ensuring consistency across different pages. They also reduce the need to transfer information over the Internet. These cookies are not stored on your computer and are deleted once you close your browser session.

Third-Party Cookies

 We utilise Google Analytics to record visits and monitor user activity on our website. This helps us identify issues, make improvements, and enhance user experience. The Google Analytics cookie names typically begin with '_utm'.
